LEVEL: Beginners

AIM: Understanding prepositions.

On In Between In front of Under Behind Next to

PROCEDURE: The teacher writes on the blackboard the prepositions, then he makes sentences with each one making reference of every preposition, then the teacher perform them by using 2 chairs, 1 waste paper basket, 1 pencil and 1 book.

He makes the question to the students: Where is the _____?

It's <u>ON</u> the chair. Preposition



where is the waste-basket? It's between the chairs.

The teacher slides and places one chair over the waste-basket, and Makes the question:



Where is the waste-basket? It's under the chair.

Then the teacher slides the chair to the right, and makes the same question:



Where is the waste-basket? It's **next to** the chair.

Then the teacher pulls the chair just behind the waste-basket, and makes the question:



Where is the waste-basket? It's <u>in front of</u> the chair.

After that he pushes the chair and places it just in front of the waste-basket, and makes the following question:



Where is the waste-basket? It's **<u>behind</u>** the chair.

And finally the teacher puts the waste-basket on the chair, and makes the question:



Where is the waste-basket? Its **on** the chair.

At this point the teacher continues interacting with his students making them answer where every item is placed.


This exercise is synchronized and speeds up a little, while the teacher moves the chairs, the waste-basket, the book, and the pencil.



where is the pencil? It's **in** the waste-basket.



Where is the pencil? It's **on** the chair.



COMMENTS: Students recognize the correct use of prepositions according to the examples performed by the teacher.

CONCLUSION: Students participate saying the preposition while the teacher is moving the chairs, waste paper basket, pencil, and book.
