

Reorganizing Sentences

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Level: 1st grade elementary

Purpose: Reading, visual discrimination, organizational skills.

Material: Computer screen

Time class: 15 minutes.

Procedure:

- 1.- Students will remember a story previously read to them called *The Wolf in Sheep's Clothing*.
- 2.- On the computer screen the students will try to figure out what is the correct order of the sentences of the story. (Scrambled story)
- 3.- Students will try to re-assemble the story.

Variation: Students might make new changes to the story.
