The Strip T's

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Over Head Projector Activity

Level: 1st grade elementary

Purpose: To practice visual discrimination and vocabulary

development.

Material: Transparency with an outline of a female body (a doll) and

clothes made of the same material that fit the doll.

Time class: 15 minutes.

Procedure:

- 1. Present the female outline and tell the students that she is getting ready to go to school.
- 2. Dress the doll and ask the students if the clothing is being put on in a proper way.
- 3. Ask students to narrate as the clothing gets on the doll.

Example:

First Liza puts on her undershirt, underpants and socks.

Next, she puts on her shirt and then her pants or skirt.

She puts a turtleneck sweater if it is cold.

Variation: Put the clothing on in the wrong order and ask a student if

that is correct.

Example: Start with the boots and then the socks.
