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Matching words and music

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Level: beginning and intermediate.

Time: 20-30 min.

Skill: Listening and speaking

Objective: To match the sounds to the types of music when listening

Materials: a C.D player, music, a marker and a whiteboard.

Procedure:

1. First, T writes different types of music on the board and numbers each. T. asks students if they are familiar with these types of music and asks for names of singers or bands.
2. Students will match the number of the type of music on the board with the correct type of music they listen to from the C.D player.
3. The teacher plays the C.D. with different types of music and the students begin to match.
4. The teacher checks the exercise with the students, asking them for the answers.
5. With the list on the board, the teacher makes questions to students like:

What kind of music do you prefer?

What kind of music do you like?

What kind of music do you dislike?

What comes to your mind when you listen to reggae?

What's the name of a rock star you know? Etc.
